



However, many of our staff are also parents and carers and will be undertaking those responsibilities in addition to providing online learning for our students.

Supervision will be available for students of **essential workers only**. Students will be supervised while they access their learning online with the other members of their classes, including their teachers, who are at home. Students will need to wear a mask while they are on site. The registration process for those students who need to attend school during the Stay-at-Home orders is available on Daranet.
